



## How to print from your Android phone or tablet

As Android technology progresses, so does your ability to get everything done right from your Android phone or tablet. Google has designed a cloud printing app that works with your printer connected either to your wireless network or to your computer via USB. Here's how to set up Google Cloud Print within Chrome on your computer and how to start printing directly from your Android device.

### How to add your printer to Google Cloud Print


1. Launch **Chrome** on your computer.
2. Click on the **menu** button in the top right corner. It looks like three vertical dots.







3. Click **Settings**.


4. Scroll down and Click **advanced**.







- 5. Scroll down and click **Google Cloud Print** Under Printing Section
- 6. Click to **Manage Cloud Print Devices**





7. Click **Add printers**.
8. Click the printers you want to be added to Google Cloud Print.
9. Click **Add printer(s)**.






## How to add the Google Cloud Print app to your Android phone or tablet

1. Launch **Play Store** from your Home Screen or app drawer.
2. Tap the **search field**.
3. Type **cloud print**.



4. Tap the **Search** button (it looks like a magnifying glass).
5. Tap **Cloud Print** by Google Inc.
6. Tap **Install**.



As long as the Google account you have activated on your computer is the same Google account activated on your phone or tablet, you'll be able to see your printer.

## How to print a local file from your Android phone

1. **Open the file** you'd like to print. You can open files stored locally (found in Photos, Gmail, Docs, file manager apps, etc.) or files stored on cloud services like Google Drive and Dropbox. In this case, we chose a picture in Photos.
2. Tap the **menu** button in the top right of your screen. It looks like three stacked dots.
3. Tap **Print**.
4. Tap the **drop-down arrow**. It's located near the top of your screen.



- 5. Tap the printer you'd like to print from.
- 6. Tap the print button. It looks like a printer.



## How to print a file from the internet with your Android phone

1. Tap the **menu** button (looks like three stacked dots) when you're viewing the webpage with the content you want to be printed. The menu button might look a bit different, depending on your browser.
2. Tap **Print**.
3. Tap the **drop-down arrow**. It is located near the top of your screen.



4. Tap the printer you'd like to print from.
5. Tap the print button (it looks like a printer).
